Service of Healing and Annointing

This rite can be deeply meaningful and affecting; great care should be taken to ensure that appropriate privacy is kept and that people are comfortable. It will be rewarding and important that ongoing teaching about healing and prayer is done in the congregation so that as many people as possible have a full and sufficiently informed understanding of how the Bible and church understand the practice of healing.

Those who take leadership in prayer will find it helpful to spend considerable time reflecting upon the most beneficial way to address certain requests so that the prayers that are offered are pastorally and theologically suitable.

One by one the presider will hear the request for healing and prayer appropriately and privately with the person.
