

Mission and Service

The purpose of the AMS is “to glorify God and support with prayer, study and service mission endeavors through the Presbyterian Church in Canada, the Synod of the Atlantic Provinces and the Presbyteries within its bounds”.

Each year AMS carries out a study related to the Mission field in our Church. This past year our study is entitled “Toward a World Without Aids”, a very interesting and thought provoking subject. We also note the work of the Presbyterian Church in Canada, its missionaries and mission projects.

Our local projects include participation in the World Day of Prayer; providing nutritional snacks for Phoenix House for one week in April, donating personal care items to Phoenix House twice yearly; providing a monthly meal for Feed Others Of Dartmouth (FOOD); conducting a Mission Awareness Sunday in the spring; providing a Bible to each child Baptized in Iona; maintaining contact with the congregation and our missionaries in the field through cards, visits etc.

We participate in Presbytery and Atlantic Synod AMS meetings.

This past year we hosted three noon luncheons at the Church to raise funds for our FOOD project. The luncheons proved popular.
