

## Minister's Message

### **Easter Surprise!**

One of the most memorable things about my ordination service was the surprise attendance of one of my best friends. She flew all the way from Saskatoon and hadn't told me she was coming! I was shocked to see her shining face on my doorstep! It was a wonderful way to show friendship and make the day extra special. I imagine the disciples had a much more powerful reaction to having Jesus show up on their doorsteps that first Easter. It was a surprise of epic proportions. Even those who'd seen Lazarus come out of his tomb were shocked that Jesus was alive after dying on the cross. Perhaps even more surprising was the compassion he showed for them.

This Easter surprise challenged them to believe that life after death was possible and that God's promises of forgiveness were true. It was a surprise that, once the confusion settled, brought them great joy. God is full

of surprises like that, surprises that challenge us to have faith and surprises that bring us great joy. It is often in these surprises that we sense the Spirit's power in the world. It's often through these surprises that we grow. We knew the resurrection was the good news at the end of the Lenten seasonno surprise for us. But as Easter people we anticipate being surprised by what new life will spring forth because of it. May you find blessing in all the Easter surprises God has to offer.
