### **Sowing seeds of hope**

*Presbyterians Sharing* supports ARISE ministry in Toronto, ON, a mission that ministers to people who need support exiting the sex trade. When the Rev. Deb Rapport began working with Brooklyn six years ago, Brooklyn was homeless, addicted to crack and involved in the sex trade to support her habit. Through counseling, friendship and support, Brooklyn journeyed from addiction to sobriety, from homelessness to being housed, from near-death to new life. Now a new mom attending school, she wants ARISE to share her story so that it might inspire others to reach out for help and to know that they are not alone. Deb shares, "ARISE Ministry prays that seeds of hope will be planted in the lives of all involved in prostitution; that they may know that change is possible."
