On July 26th, the Rev. Bill Strong, the rector of the Anglican parish of Upper Island Cove and a friend of Rev. Bob Rowlands. will join us for our worship. Bob received a message from Bill saying, "Hi Bob: My Great, Great Grand Father was the Rev. Dr. Donald Gordon Fraser who was the first minister at St. Andrew's Church in 1854. He was born on the Isle of Mull in Scotland but came to Newfoundland from Nova Scotia. He died in 1856. There is a house opposite Bannerman Park on the Corner of Fraser's lane that was sent to his widow along with a carpenter after his death. Years ago, my first cousin, Rev Margaret Goodwin, a United Church Minister, preached at the Kirk in his honour as well."
