### A Time Called ... EASTER SEASON

In a way, Easter is a "moveable feast" which, unlike Christmas with its set date, falls on the Sunday after the full moon following March 21. It is easy to fall back into "life as normal" after Easter. But, the season of Easter – 40 days – is Christendom's most meaningful and historic celebration.

#### **Historical Roots of Easter Season**

The Easter Season – or Eastertide – is seven weeks after Easter. It seems likely that Eastertide was modeled after the Jewish festival of Shavuot, The Festival of Weeks, which was seven weeks long and ended with the celebration of Shavuot on the 50th day. In Christian tradition, the Easter season leads us to celebrate Pentecost, the gift of God's Holy Spirit on the 50th day.

### Finding Meaning in the Tradition

As with Christmas, there may be an emotional slump after Easter. The Easter season – Eastertide – is, therefore, a good time to engage in something new in mission, something daring and innovative. Gather up your slow cookers and serve soup on the main street of your town. 
