<u>PWS&D Message</u> Improving Health Across Generations in Guatemala

For eight years, Blanca Juárez Tomas has participated in Flor de Tuichmad'il—a women's collective dedicated to promoting health and nutrition among her community in Guatemala. Blanca shares how being involved in this group has allowed her to support her own well-being and that of the next two generations in her family.

"Before I became part of the women's group, Flor de Tuichmad'il, my life was very different. I didn't give as much importance to nutrition for both me and my family. The foods we consumed did not have sources of protein, and we did not take into account the importance of properly washing the food that we ate, which often led to illness.

When I became part of the AMMID association, I learned which foods contain protein and the importance of hygiene at home. Now, my family is healthier, and I am teaching my children to put these things into practice with my grandchildren so that they can enjoy good health."

Scripture: Luke 1: 57–80 [NT 57]

Now the time came for Elizabeth to give birth, and she bore a son. Her neighbors and relatives heard that the Lord had shown his great mercy to her, and they rejoiced with her.

On the eighth day they came to circumcise the child, and they were going to name him Zechariah after his father. But his mother said, *"No; he is to be called John."*

They said to her, "None of your relatives has this name."

Then they began motioning to his father to find out what name he wanted to give him. He asked for a writing tablet and wrote, *"His name is John."* And all of them were amazed. Immediately his mouth was opened and his tongue freed, and he began to speak, praising God. Fear came over all their neighbors, and all these things were talked about throughout the entire hill country of Judea. All who heard them pondered them and said, *"What then will this child become?"* For indeed the hand of the Lord was with him.

Then his father Zechariah was filled with the Holy Spirit and prophesied:

"Blessed be the Lord God of Israel, for he has looked favorably on his people and redeemed them. He has raised up a mighty savior for us in the house of his child David, as he spoke through the mouth of his holy prophets from of old, that we would be saved from our enemies and from the hand of all who hate us. Thus he has shown the mercy promised to our ancestors and has remembered his holy covenant, the oath that he swore to our ancestor Abraham, to grant us that we, being rescued from the hands of our enemies, might serve him without fear, in holiness and righteousness in his presence all our days. And you, child, will be called the prophet of the Most High, for you will go before the Lord to prepare his ways to give his people knowledge of salvation by the forgiveness of their sins. Because of the tender mercy of our God, the dawn from on high will break upon us, to shine upon those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace."

The child grew and became strong in spirit, and he was in the wilderness until the day he appeared publicly to Israel.
