**READING:** Isaiah 9:2-7

<u>Reader:</u> The wilderness and the dry land shall be glad, the desert shall rejoice and blossom;

ALL: like the crocus it shall blossom abundantly, and rejoice with joy and singing.

Reader: We light the candle of joy.

Reader: The Lord will give you a sign.
Look the young woman is with child
ALL: and shall bear a son,
and shall name him Immanuel - God is with us.

Reader: We light the candle of love.

<u>Reader:</u> The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light;

ALL: those who lived in a land of deep darkness on them light has shined.

<u>Reader:</u> The centre candle in our Advent wreath is the Christ candle. From this light, all good gifts come. We light this candle remembering the One who is the Light of the world.

ALL: Let us walk in the light of the Lord.
