PROFESSION OF OUR FAITH

(A Catechism for Today Questions 48 & 49)

MINISTER: What do we confess in saying, "on the third day he rose again from the dead"?

TOGETHER: Jesus was raised by the mighty act of God. The loving Father did not forsake the Son. Jesus appeared to Mary Magdalene and "the other Mary" at the tomb, to the disciples in and near Jerusalem and in Galilee, and also to over five hundred persons at one time. The resurrection is God's victory over death, and the core of our faith; "if Christ be not raised, we are of all people most to be pitied".

MINISTER: Why is Jesus' resurrection so important?

TOGETHER: It means that death is not final and that we too will have life after death.
