#### Old Testament Scripture Reading: Ecclesiastes 4: 1-4 (NIV)

Again I looked and saw all the oppression that was taking place under the sun: I saw the tears of the oppressed— and they have no comforter; power was on the side of their oppressors— and they have no comforter. <sup>2</sup> And I declared that the dead, who had already died, are happier than the living, who are still alive.
