Their experience of teaching in Bangladesh in the 1990s will be put to good use, from January to November 2020. They are active members of Knox Church, Woodstock, where they both sing in the choir and are elders.

When asked why they want to serve, Steve replied: "Jesus talked a lot about loving one's friends and enemies. I believe this should be the root of our faith, not doctrinal arguments. We serve a risen savior, who loves us, so we are called to love." Nora understands the mission as "a mutual sharing of experience and expertise among partners. Together as a Church, we must understand each other."
