Lora will empower Nepali team leaders; develop a staff support group for Nepali UMN staff; plan and facilitate retreats; encourage UMN Christian staff in the habits of prayer, Bible study and Christian fellowship; support children of expatriates by providing discussion sessions on cross-cultural issues; visit UMN expatriate staff and families based outside Kathmandu.

Lora is joined by her spouse Mitch Rhodes who has accepted the position of Expatriate Coordinator with UMN supported by Mennonite Mission Network, and their two younger children. Two older boys will remain at home to continue their education.

Lora shares, “I am really excited for Mitch and me to be sent by both Presbyterians and Mennonites to work in such a broadly ecumenical program.”
