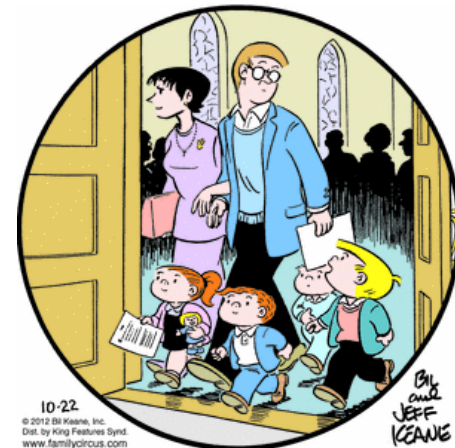
Food Bank Sunday – Today.
