SERMON: The promised Holy Spirit

The main focus of today's message is from Acts. The resurrected Jesus stayed with people for 40 days before his ascension. Jesus promised another Advocate. <u>John 14:15-18, "If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, to be with you for ever. This is the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, because he abides with you, and he will be in you. I will not leave you orphaned; I am coming to you."</u>

We are holding onto this promise of God, so we are to be confident carrying out our own Christ-follower identity, even after Jesus left us. Through the Holy Spirit abiding in us, we are with Jesus. This year, the 40 days mark, the ascension of Jesus, is May 9th, this Thursday. We don't have special worship service, but I hope you can remember that day. On the day of ascension, Jesus returned to heaven. Jesus left the earth completing his mission. But, as he promised, he will

not leave us orphaned. Therefore, he gave us the promise of the Holy Spirit. As we can see from the passage of Acts 10, gentiles received the Holy Spirit. This means, God extended his invitation to become God's family to all people. We have the invitation to be the family of God. We have the promise to receive the Holy Spirit.

Recently, I heard <u>Arnold Schwarzenegger's</u> motivation speech. He is the actor from movie, <u>Terminator</u>, as well as a <u>former governor of California</u>. He was born in Austria. His parents were farmers. They wanted him to become a farmer and to carry on their family farm. But, Arnold didn't want the same life as his parents. He didn't want a quiet rural small village life, but he wanted skyscrapers, busy-ness of city life. He began searching how to escape from farming life in his small town. I am not saying that becoming a farmer is bad, but to Arnold, he had a different dream. In his searching, he found a bodybuilding magazine with a picture of Reg Park.

At the age of 14, he found his role model. He wanted to become like **Reg Park**. He had a dream. He found his clear goal. Of course, there were hindrances and challenges. But, because he had a clear goal, he never stopped. He had the motivation to accomplish his dream. He wanted to be like Reg Park. A famous bodybuilder, a movie star. And he wanted to live in America. At the age of 20, Arnold became mister universe. He exercised for 5 to 6 six hours daily. People asked why? Isn't it difficult? What can you become doing that? He didn't listen to the people when they say "he cannot." Because he had a clear dream.

As he took challenges, he said, "lifting the dumbbell was tiring and exhausting. But, I was able to overcome it because if I lift this dumbbell few more times, I knew that it would lead me to my dream closer. Through enduring these challenging actions, I was coming closer to my dream." That's how he overcame. He had a clear vision where he wanted to go. And he did not listen to naysayers, but he looked at his role model, his clear goal.

The examples of Arnold Schwarzenegger gives us an idea that we need something to look at.

Jesus ascended and the Holy Spirit came down to us. From Acts passage, when the gentiles received the Holy Spirit, what did they do? They were baptized. What does this baptism mean? What happens in baptism? We sprinkle some water on the head. It is the symbol of going into the water. Baptists put a person in the water. They make the person immersed. When we go under the water, what happens? We cannot breathe. We die when we are under the water. But, when we come out, we can breathe. We live. This is baptism. When we go under the water, we die. And with the life of God, with the power of God, we are redeemed from the water. We are rescued from the power of death and sin. So, we live again with the life from God.

2 Corinthians 5:17, "So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new!"

When we receive the Holy Spirit, we are filled with it and we are to bear fruit. Last week, we talked about Jesus becoming the tree and we becoming the branches. So, we are to bear fruit of Jesus Christ.

John 15:16, Jesus says, "You did not choose me but I chose you. And I appointed you to go and bear fruit, fruit that will last, so that the Father will give you whatever you ask him in my name."

We receive the Holy Spirit by the will of God. We cannot earn the Holy Spirit. We cannot find the Holy Spirit with our own ability. God chose to pour out his Holy Spirit upon us. God also appointed us to bear fruit. When we pray, we are able to get answers. But, there is one condition

- <u>IN MY NAME</u>. When we ask God whatever WE WANT, it's questionable that God will grant us our self-willed prayers. If I ask for a sports car, <u>Lamborghini</u>, a half of million dollar sports car, would God listen to my prayer? Maybe. But, can we say that, it's the will of God? Do I really need the most luxurious sports car for the sake of the glory of Jesus? My answer to this question could be no.

When we have new life in God, our old self is changed through the power of the Holy Spirit.

To find out the price of Lamborghini, I went to their website and I saw an ad. It says, Lamborghini is for BAR-RAISERS. <u>Bar raisers</u>. <u>Comfort zone escapers. Pressure embracers.</u> These are the words they used.

Think about the works of the Holy Spirit. Because we have new life from the Holy Spirit, our life is changed. We have different perspectives now. We are now bar raisers. We cannot stay in our comfort zone because of the Holy Spirit. We are comfort zone escapers. Because we live with the power of God, we have different power. We are able to endure in pressures. That's the meaning of patience. We are pressure embracers with the power of the Holy Spirit.

How do you like these words? These are our new identities with the promise of the Holy Spirit! Would you dream with me to become bar-raisers, comfort zone escapers, and pressure embracers!

Let us dream together the Holy Spirit filled life.

What kinds of church dose the Holy Spirit want from us? What kinds of worship does he expect from us as he pours out his power and glory upon us?

What kinds of life are we to live as Jesus followers having the Holy Spirit within our hearts? What kinds of fruit are we to bear because of the presence of the Hoy Spirit in our daily lives?

Arnold Schwarzenegger had a dream and his dream became the signpost for his life's direction and guidance leading toward his goals and purpose and values.

The promise for the Holy Spirit was given to us. All we need is to claim it to God. God, we come to your feet to receive the Holy Spirit as you promised to us. Fill us with the Holy Spirit. Help us discern, guide our steps, give us courage. Make us bar raisers, comfort zone escapers, pressure embraces, peacemakers, witnesses of the gospel, and role models of your church for the next generations. May the intimate fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you.

This is the message of the Lord for us today.

<u>born of</u> the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead. <u>On the third</u> day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, <u>he is seated</u> at the right hand of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead.

<u>I believe</u> in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, <u>the resurrection</u> of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

(Great Prayer of Thanksgiving:) (Please say BOLD print together)

L: The Lord be with you. P: And also, with you.

L: Lift up your hearts. P: We lift them to the Lord.

L: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. P: It is right to give God thanks and praise.

L: It is our joy and privilege to praise and worship you, Almighty God. With a rush of wind and tongues of fie, you fulfilled the promise of Jesus Christ by sending us your Holy Spirit to form your church. By the same Holy Spirit, you poured out your grace upon us with gifts, empowered us to proclaim your gospel and to serve you in our surroundings. In your presence, with the joy of your salvation and all your deeds for us, we lift our voices and hearts <u>in joyful praise:</u>

(Sanctus) Holy, Holy, Holy Lord, God of power and might, Heaven and earth are full of Your glory, Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.

L: Jesus Christ, our Lord and Saviour, you gave your life for us. You did not run away from the dreadful death on the cross. That's all because of your love for us. We praise and worship you for your incarnation, for your life on earth, for your sufferings and death upon the cross, for your resurrection from the dead, for your glorious return to God the Father, for your promise of sending your Holy Spirit, and for your glorious return for us. With all our hearts, we proclaim the mystery of faith:

P: Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again.

L: Holy Spirit, who lives in us, stir our hearts. Make us escape from our comfort zones. Help us boldly raise the bar and embrace challenges and pressures in our lives. Fill us with your power from above. Fill our hearts with your love. Through Christ, by Christ, with Christ, in Christ, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honour are yours, almighty God, for ever and ever. Amen.

Loving God, thank you for the Holy Spirit. Thank you for the guidance and comfort. We rely upon you alone. We worship you and we praise you. In Jesus' precious name, we pray. Amen.
