## St Mark's Presbyterian Church, Orillia POLICY ON WEDDINGS

In accordance with the policy of The Presbyterian Church in Canada the Session of St Mark's Presbyterian Church has determined that for our congregation, marriage is a covenant between two people and, subject to this policy, is pleased to be a part of weddings on that basis.

We ask that:

- The couple will be desirous of a Christian marriage service.
- The couple will provide a marriage licence at least two weeks before the wedding.

The church is willing to provide:

- The Sanctuary for the conduct of the wedding.
- The services of a minister to plan the service with you, conduct a rehearsal and conduct the wedding in accordance with the laws of province. It is customary to provide an honorarium for the minister.
- The services of an organist at a fee of \$100 payable to the organist prior to the Wedding.
- The minister of the congregation and music director shall be given the right of first refusal for all weddings. A guest clergy officiant or assistant may be considered by the minister.
- The marriage will be recorded in the marriage register of the congregation and filed with the appropriate government department in a timely manner.
- Custodial services at a fee of \$100 payable to the church/custodian prior to the Wedding.
- Hall space for a reception can be arranged if required.
- No confetti or other material may be thrown within the church.
- Decorations (ribbons, flowers etc.) may be placed in the sanctuary provided they do not cause any damage. Flowers and decorations should be removed from the sanctuary following the ceremony.
- If you require the use of the Elevator, this must be arranged at the time of booking. The Elevator operator must be approved and trained by St. Mark's.
- Additional financial gifts to the church in order to support the cost of maintenance of our facility would be appreciated.
