Goderich Street Resurfacing Phase 2

Goderich Street between Mill Street and Elgin Street will be closed starting on Tuesday May 20th for a period of four weeks (weather permitting).

Phase 2 includes water system improvements, replacement of the brick maple leaf design in the Mill Street and Elgin Street intersections and asphalt resurfacing.

Work will generally occur Monday to Friday, 7 am to 7 pm.

There will be no traffic or parking access during this time; pedestrian access will be maintained.

Parking will be available on adjacent side streets and at the Municipal parking lots on Bricker Street and Elgin Street.

Water service to the church will be shut off on Monday May 26 (7 am to 7 pm) and Monday June 2 (7 am to 7 pm).
