Narration of Steps - Pastor Martin

At the regular meeting of the Presbytery of Westminster on December 6, 2022 the presbytery <u>approved</u> that the congregation of Knox Presbyterian Church, the congregation of Gordon Presbyterian Church and the congregation of St Aidan's Presbyterian Church, be amalgamated, effective date January 1 2023, and <u>be known as Trinity Presbyterian Church</u>.
